

To visitors to Teshima

Many residents of Teshima are elderly, and do not have adequate medical and emergency transport system. (No ambulance available.)

If you notice having a fever or any other changes in your physical condition, please refrain from visiting the island.

We pay heed to the health management of all island residents and visitors.

Protective Measures for COVID-19

- Wear a mask. But take extra care to avoid heat stroke during the summer.
- If you are not wearing a mask, you may be denied access to the art facility or store.
- Wear a mask even when talking to people outdoors if you are unable to maintain sufficient distance from others.
- Please disinfect your hands carefully using alcohol-based disinfectant.
- Some facilities and stores may request temperature measurement.
- The number of admissions to buses and art facilities is limited.
- Please cooperate with any other requests regarding infection prevention measures.
- Teshima is a place where residents live. Please mind your manners.

We ask that you understand the above, and enjoy your time in Teshima. Cooperation by every individual will keep Teshima safe.

If you have a suspect to have COVID-19 infection, please contact the following.

(Symptoms: breathlessness, strong lethargy, high fever, etc. /underlying disease that can easily develop into a serious illness with relatively mild symptoms of cold such as fever and cough.)
